INSTRUCTIONS FOR GROWING YOUR CHIA PET®

- 1. Fully submerge Chia Pet® in water and soak for half an hour.
- Mix 2 teaspoons of chia seeds with 2 tablespoons(1/8 cup) of water in a separate container. Wait 5 minutes then stir the seed mixture until you get a jam-like consistency.
- 3. Remove and empty water out of the Chia Pet®. Let it sit for 2-3 minutes, then apply a thin, even layer of seeds to the outside of the clay.
- TIP: If seeds appear too dry and hard to spread, stir in a little more water. If the seeds are too runny, stir in a small amount of seeds.
- 4. Let seeds dry and do not water for 2 days.
- After 2 days, fill the Chia Pet® with water using the hole at the top of the planter and place in drip tray.
- TIP: To help seeds sprout, place a plastic bag loosely over your Chia Pet® at night to create a greenhouse effect, taking it off in the morning. The bag should not be sealed and should be big enough that it does not touch the seeds on the Chia Pet®.
- Top the Chia Pet[®] off with fresh water and empty the drip tray every day. Seeds should sprout in 3-4 days.
- TIP: Chia Pet® planters do best in a spot where it will receive plenty of fresh air and sunlight.
- 7. When growth appears leggy or overgrown, it is time to remove the old growth, wash the Chia Pet®, and replant. Seed packet contains enough seeds for 3 plantings. Chia Pet® planters can be washed and reused indefinitely.
